Rover Rescue is an important section of the Club, which is in close contact with the County Council Emergency Planning Department and is part of the 'National 4x4 Response Network'.

Vehicles, equipment and volunteers are prepared to be called out to assist the County in times of need, such as extreme weather or flooding.

We try to hold regular training sessions, including first aid and navigation skills. The Club has been involved with conservation projects with the Suffolk Wildlife

Trust: Winch equipped Land Rover's proving to be the perfect vehicles for working in areas otherwise inaccessible for other volunteers.

We also raise money for charity organisations:

CLIMB (Children Living with Metabolic Diseases, EACH (East Anglia's Children's Hospices), Essex Autistic Society, Cancer Care in Suffolk and other worthy causes have recently received monies raised by our members at our events and various countryside shows we have attended.

The club thrives on a friendly, sociable attitude, where everyone is welcome to come and join in - so if you live in or around Suffolk and have an interest in Land Rovers come along and join in the fun.
